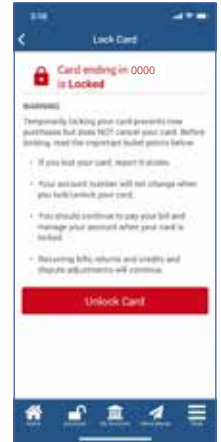
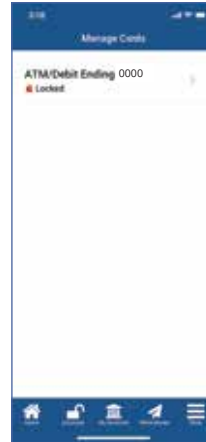

## Debit Card Controls

1st Street Credit Union debit cardholders have the ability to turn their debit card(s) ON or OFF on our Mobile App. This feature lets you take control of your debit card and protect yourself from against unauthorized use. If you have misplaced your card, turn it to the OFF position. If you find it, and feel your account has not been jeopardized, turn it back ON and continue to use your card. If you use your card infrequently or are traveling without your card, turn it OFF. Then, turn it ON when you are ready to use it. You are in control!

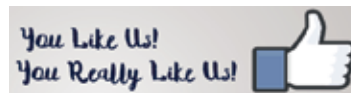
## How to be prepared for Hurricane Season
