

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- Two grants are awarded in the amount of \$1,500 each.
- Previous recipients are not eligible to apply.
- Each applicant must have their own account in good standing with 1st Street Credit Union for a minimum of 6 months prior to submitting a grant request.
- Two (2) current (not past 60 days) letters of recommendation from teachers, guidance counselors, employers or school administrators will be accepted. Letters from family will not be accepted.
- High school students must submit acceptance letters or student I.D. from college or trade school, applicant is planning to attend. College students must be currently enrolled in an accredited technical program, college, or university. If you are transferring to a different college, university, or trade school, you must submit a copy of your acceptance letter.
- In 500 words or less (typed and double spaced) describe the manner in which this grant will assist you in achieving your goals.
- Applications are accepted until the close of business on the 3rd Friday in April. Applicants will be notified no later than the last business day in June.
- Grant recipients will be selected without regard to age, disability, gender, marital status, national origin, race, religion, sexual orientation, or veteran status.
- It is important that you provide an explanation of why requested information cannot be provided.
- Applications not accompanied by the required documents will be considered incomplete. Items cannot be held and matched. Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be considered.
- Successful applicants will be required to furnish a current photo or be photographed at the Credit Union for use in the 1st Street's marketing campaigns.
- A check will be issued in the name of the recipient and the school. If the recipient does not enroll during the semester for which the grant is provided, the grant will be forfeited and returned to 1st Street.
